Ambassador Ioannis Vrailas is the Deputy Head of the Delegation of the European Union to the United Nations since July 2011. He is on secondment to the European External Action Service from the Foreign Ministry of Greece, which he joined in 1985. He served in the Greek Permanent Mission to the UN in New York, the Greek Permanent Representation to the EU in Brussels (twice) and was Deputy Chief of Mission in Teheran and, most recently, in Washington (2009-2011). When in Athens, he held several EU-related posts, including Deputy Director for Common Foreign and Security Policy from 1999 to 2003 (which included the Greek Presidency in the first semester of 2003). He is married to Christiane Bourloyannis and has three children. He speaks English, French, Italian and Spanish.
